

Route 2: Stavanger - to the isle of Halsnøy (With 2013 prices)

- Follow E-39 north towards Bergen, through Stavanger (20 NOK Automatic toll - Autopass).
- **Drive through without stopping! (* see info below)**
- Drive through the Rennfast-tunnel (no toll) until reaching Mortavika ferry port.
- Take the ferry to Arsvågen. The trip costs about 176 NOK for 1 car with driver, and 38 NOK per adult. (if retired = retired instructions!) For times of departure, study the timetables. (www.fjord1.no)
- Continue in the direction of Bergen on E-39. In Våg there is an automatic toll booth (12 NOK Autopass). **Drive through without stopping! (* see info below)**

Note! Alternative route to Utbjoa:

From Våg follow E-134 to Ølensvåg (towards Oslo). Continue to Utbjoa, about 20 minutes, and the ferry port Utbjoa. ***Please study the timetables; unfortunately this ferry only makes about 5 trips per day.*** The cost is about 114 NOK for 1 car with driver, and 39 NOK per adult.

- Continue driving towards Stord, through the Bømlafjord-tunnel (no toll) and to the isle of Stord.

*Alternative route Skjersholmane:

- Keep following E-39 further towards Bergen, to the sign „Ranavik 544“ and head towards the right.
- In the first roundabout make a right turn and continue towards the marked ferry. On ferry harbour Skjersholmane position Yourself on the track to Ranavik. The trip lasts for 40 min. and costs about 137 NOK for 1 car with driver, and 46 NOK per adult. For times of departure, study the timetables. (www.tide.no)

**Alternative route Jektevik (only the night ferry at 00.40 AM):

- **Note; this ferry travels every evening, except for the night before Monday.**
- Continue on E 39, passing the markings towards Ranavik and Leirvik, and keep following E-39 for 15 minutes to the sign marked with Jektevik ferry port.
- Make a right turn and on the ferry harbour, position yourself on the track to Ranavik.
- The trip lasts for 45 min. and costs about 133 NOK for 1 car with driver, and 44 NOK per adult. For times of departure, study the timetables. (www.tide.no)

* Info regarding fully automatic toll booths.

Drive through without stopping! How to pay:

1. **With AutoPASS electronic tag.** Contract and electronic tag is available at the Servicestations. (for people who often pass toll stations).

2. **Without an AutoPASS electronic tag.** If you don't have an AutoPASS or a [Visitors' Payment contract](#), the invoice is sent to the vehicle owner by standard mail. This invoice is sent from Euro Parking Collection (EPC) plc in London, United Kingdom. It can take up to six months before this invoice is sent.

3. **Pay at the Servicestation.** You can also pay the toll fee at facilities, such as petrol stations close to the toll station, within three working days (after passing the toll point). Look for the sign: "Kr-service".

Travelling distances/times:

Stavanger harbour – Mortavika = 32 km and ca. 40 minutes.

Ferry Mortavika – Arsvågen = 25 minutes.

Arsvågen – Skjersholmane = 84 km and ca. 1 hour 10 minutes.

Arsvågen – Jektevik = 98 km and ca. 1 hour 25 minutes.

Arsvågen – Utbjoa = 84 km and ca. 1 hour 15 minutes.
